

HAIR & MAKEUP FACILITATOR

The Hair and Makeup (H/M) Facilitator works closely with TWS' Costume Shop Supervisor and individual Costume Designer to implement hair and makeup designs for a production in either our 500-seat proscenium Mainstage theater or for our 95-seat black box Studio theater, which includes navigating college purchasing processes and managing supplies (wigs, hair pieces, makeup and styling products and tools).

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

- Collaborate with Costume Designer(s) to facilitate character looks through stage makeup and hair/wig styling and determine change/quick change needs.
- Train/Oversee makeup/hair student crew in the proper application, removal, and care of all makeup, wigs, pieces, facial hairpieces, and prosthetics for the production
- Lead a H/M workshops for the cast and crew on proper application of their makeup, style their hair or wearing of wigs according to the determined style of individual productions.
- Attend in-person designer run-through rehearsals and create a working plot for placement of H/M supplies/materials/personnel based on the needs of the show.
- Maintain and re-style wigs/hairpieces for each performance weekend (4-5 weekends depending on the production).
- Clean and restock all makeup supplies, wigs, hairpieces, and facial hair after the production closes.
