THE STORY:

Tuck Everlasting is a wonderful family musical based on the well-beloved children's book by Natalie Babbitt that is a perfect holiday experience to share with loved ones.

The musical, like the best-selling book, is an imaginative and magical tale about Winnie Foster, a young girl rebelling against the societal expectations that limit her strong will and desire for freedom, and how her life changes when she chances upon the mysterious Tuck family while wandering in the woods.
