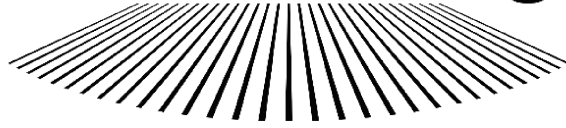


# The Western Stage
